



Heritage Festival Event:

Australia's oldest church, Ebenezer Church

Sat 20th May 2017 11am to 2.30pm

In 1802 eight families arrived in the colony with the intent of being settled together, becoming farmers and later building their own church. When they settled on the banks of the Hawkesbury River they were joined by seven other families and in 1809 they built Ebenezer Church.

This event includes a talk on the church history, a two-course lunch and walk-and-talks in the colonial graveyard, to the historic tree, riverside beach and quarry.
